

#### MATERIALS

### BRAT PACK BLOCK BY AMY GUNSON FEATURING CIRRUS SOLIDS

Option 1 | Molly: Cirrus Solids

A: 1/4 yard Sprout

B: 1/4 yard Amber

C: ½ yard Sky

D: ½ yard Petal

 $E: 2^{1}/8 \text{ yards Ash}$ 

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard Binding 3 1/8 yards Backing Option 2 | Judd: Cirrus Solids

A: 1/4 yard Fuchsia

B: 1/4 yard Lava

C: 1/2 yard Charcoal

D: 1/2 yard Iris

E: 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards Ocean

#### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.

Cut from:

Color A: 16- 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares

Color B: 16- 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares

Color C: 32- 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares

Color D: 32- 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares

Color **■** 32- 3½" squares

32 - 3½" x 6½" rectangles

 $64 - 3^{7}/8$ " squares

# ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

- 1. Place one Color A 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square and one Color B 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line and sew ¼" along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. The squares will measure 3½" and will create two A/B square units. [fig 1]
- 2. Repeat step 1 and pair Color  $\bigcirc$  3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square with Color  $\bigcirc$  3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square to create four  $\bigcirc$  E units.
- 3. Repeat step 1 and pair Color D  $3^{7}/8^{"}$  square with Color E  $3^{7}/8^{"}$  square to create four D/E units.

#### **ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK**

- 4. Lay out the HST units, squares and rectangles into four rows [fig 2] referring to BLOCK DIAGRAM for color placement. Sew together using ¼" seam allowance. Press the seams of row 1 and 3 towards the left and the seams of row 2 and 4 to the right.
- 5. Sew horizontal rows to complete block. Make 15 remaining blocks.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

6. Follow quilt diagram turning blocks to make design. Sew 4 blocks to make horizontal rows (additional yardage needed for larger quilts shown). Sew the rows to complete quilt.




