## BRAT PACK BLOCK BY AMY GUNSON FEATURING CIRRUS SOLIDS

Option 1 | Molly: Cirrus Solids
A: 1/4 yard Sprout
B: 1/4 yard Amber
C: 1/2 yard Sky
D: 1/2 yard Petal
E: $21 / 8$ yards Ash

Option $2 \mid$ Judd: Cirrus Solids
A: 1/4 yard Fuchsia
B: 1/4 yard Lava
C: 1/2 yard Charcoal
D: 1/2 yard Iris
E: $2^{1 / 8}$ yards Ocean
$3 / 8$ yard Binding
$3^{1 / 8}$ yards Backing

## cutting directions

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.
Cut from:
Color $A: 16-3^{7 / 8} 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Color D: 32- $3^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Color B: $16-3^{7 / 8} 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Color C: 32- 37/8" squares

Color E: 32- $\mathbf{3}^{1 / 2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ squares
32-3½" x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
$64-3^{7 / 8} 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Place one Color $A 3^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}$ square and one Color $B 3^{7 /} 8^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. The squares will measure $3 \not 12^{\prime \prime}$ and will create two $A / B$ square units. [fig 1]
2. Repeat step 1 and pair Color C $3^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}$ square with Color $E 3^{7 /} 8^{\prime \prime}$ square to create four C/E units.
3. Repeat step 1 and pair Color $D 3^{7 / 8} 8^{\prime \prime}$ square with Color $E 3^{7 / 8}$ " square to create four $D / E$ units.

## ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK

4. Lay out the HST units, squares and rectangles into four rows [fig 2] referring to BLOCK

DIAGRAM for color placement. Sew together using $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance. Press the seams of row 1 and 3 towards the left and the seams of row 2 and 4 to the right.
5. Sew horizontal rows to complete block. Make 15 remaining blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY
6. Follow quilt diagram turning blocks to make design. Sew 4 blocks to make horizontal rows (additional yardage needed for larger quilts shown). Sew the rows to complete quilt.
