



MATERIALS

LATTICE BLOCK BY STACEY DAY FEATURING CIRRUS SOLIDS

Fabric requirements for a 16 block quilt

Option 1 | Shoreline: Cirrus Solids

A: 1/2 yard Coral

B: 1 yard Limestone

C: 1¹/₄ yard Shadow

D: 1/4 yard Rain

Option 2 | Deep Sea: Cirrus Solids

A: ½ yard Turquoise

B: 1 yard Sky

C: 11/4 yard Ocean

D: 1/4 yard Amazon

³/₈ yard Binding

31/8 yards Backing

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances

Cut from:

Color A: 16- 51/2" squares

Color B: 32- 2" x 8½" rectangles

32- 2" x 5½" rectangles

32- 2" x 2½" rectangles

Color C: 64- 2½" x 7" rectangles

32- 2½" squares

Color D: 32- 2½" squares

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- 1. Sew Color B 2" x 5½" rectangle to the top and bottom of 5½" square. [fig 1]
- 2. Sew Color B 2" x 8½" rectangle to the sides of the block from Step 1. [fig 2] Press and trim to equal 8½" square.
- 3. Sew Color B 2" x 2½" rectangle to one end of Color C 2½" x 7" rectangle. [fig 3] Make four. Press and set two aside.
- 4. Take two pieces from Step 3, sew Color C 2½" square to the end of Color B. [fig 4]
- 5. Sew Color D 2½" square to the opposite end of the strip from Step 4. [fig 5]

ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK

- 6. Sew the pieces set aside from Step 3 to the top and bottom of the framed square from Step 2. *Note:* Color B rectangle is in the top left and bottom right of the square. *[fig 6]*
- 7. Sew the pieces from Step 5 to the sides to complete the block. [fig 7] Note: Color C square is in the top left and bottom right of the block. Press and trim the block to 12½" square.

OUILT ASSEMBLY

8. Follow QUILT DIAGRAM turning blocks to make design. Sew 4 blocks to make horizontal rows (additional yardage needed for some quilt layouts shown). Sew the rows to complete quilt.
