



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MATERIALS

BARN DOOR BLOCK BY JERRIANN MASSEY FEATURING CIRRUS SOLIDS

Fabric requirements for a 16 block quilt

Option 1 | Daytime: Cirrus Solids

A: 11/8 yards Amazon B: 3/4 yard Limestone

C: 1/4 yard Ash

D: 5/8 yard Coral

Option 2 | Nighttime: Cirrus Solids

³/₈ yard Binding

A: 11/8 yards Iris

3 yards Backing

B: ½ yard Midnight

C: 1/3 yard Ash

D: 5/8 yard Limestone

Note: All possible care has been taken to assure the accuracy of this pattern. We are not responsible for printing errors or the manner in which individual work varies. Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.

Option 1

Color A: 16-2½" x 12½" rectangles

32- 2½" x 10½" rectangles

Color **B**: 16- 4½" x 10½" rectangles

Color C: 16-2½" x 4½" rectangles

Color **D**: 16- 4½" x 8½" rectangles

Option 2

Cut from: Color **A**: 16- 2½" x 12½" rectangles

16- 4½" x 10½" rectangles

Color **B**: 16- 2½" x 10½" rectangles

16- 2½" x 4½" rectangles

Color **C**: 16- 2½" x 10½" rectangles

Color **D**: 16- 4½" x 8½" rectangles

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Cut from:

- 1. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the end of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. [fig 1]
- 2. Sew two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, one on each side, to the unit pieced in Step 1. [fig 2]

Note: For Color Option 2, Color B is sewn to the left side of the unit and Color C is sewn to the right side of the pieced unit.

- 3. Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the pieced unit in Step 2. [fig 3]
- 4. Sew the 2½" x 12½" rectangle across the top to complete the block. [fig 4] Make 16 blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 5. Arrange blocks following QUILT DIAGRAM. Sew 4 blocks in horizontal rows. Make 4 rows (additional yardage needed for some quilt layouts shown).
- 6. Sew rows together to complete the quilt.
