Fabric requirements for a 16 block quilt

| Option $1 \mid$ Daytime: Cirrus Solids | Option $2 \mid$ Nighttime: Cirrus Solids | $3 / 8$ yard Binding |
| :---: | :--- | :--- |
| A: $1^{1 / 8}$ yards Amazon | A: $1^{1 / 8}$ yards Iris | 3 yards Backing |
| B: $3 / 4$ yard Limestone | B: $1 / 2$ yard Midnight |  |
| C: $1 / 4$ yard Ash | C: $1 / 3$ yard Ash |  |
| D: $5 / 8$ yard Coral | D: $5 / 8$ yard Limestone |  |

Note: All possible care has been taken to assure the accuracy of this pattern. We are not responsible for printing errors or the manner in which individual work varies. Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS <br> Cutting dimensions include ${ }^{1 / 411}$ seam allowances.

## Option 1

Cut from:
Color A: $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles 32- $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ " rectangles

Color B: 16-41/2" x 101/2" rectangles
Color C: $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Color D: $16-41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Option 2
Cut from:
Color A: 16- $2^{1 / 21}$ " x $12^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles
16-41/2" x $10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Color B: $16-2^{1 / 2 "}$ x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
$16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Color C: $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Color D: $16-4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew the $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the end of the $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. [fig 1]
2. Sew two $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles, one on each side, to the unit pieced in Step 1. [fig 2]

Note: For Color Option 2, Color B is sewn to the left side of the unit and Color C is sewn to the right side of the pieced unit.
3. Sew the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the pieced unit in Step 2. [fig 3]
4. Sew the $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle across the top to complete the block. [fig 4] Make 16 blocks.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange blocks following QUILT DIAGRAM. Sew 4 blocks in horizontal rows. Make 4 rows (additional yardage needed for some quilt layouts shown).
6. Sew rows together to complete the quilt.
