QUILT SIZE: approximately 48" x 60"

MATERIALS	YARDS
7 prints (indicated as a-g below)	1/3 yd each print
White	1 1/3 yd
Black printed sashing	1/3 yd
Binding	1/2 yd
Backing	3 1/2 vd






Fig. 2 ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP





ASSEMBLY (all seam allowances 1/4")

- ① Start with Whole Bunting Blocks: Mark the 2.5" white corner squares diagonally (Fig. 1). Line up a square flush with the bottom corners of Whole Bunting Block and stitch on line (Fig.1a).
- ② Trim excess to 1/4" seam allowance. (Fig. 1b) Press seam allowance towards print. (Fig. 1c)
- 3 For Half Bunting Blocks refer to (Fig. 2b) to sew the correct corners on fabrics a, b, f, g.
- ④ To create the rows of Bunting: add the vertical sashings where needed according to (Fig. 2a and 2b). Then piece them across in rows. Doing all the Bunting rows first.
- ⑤ Create longer white horizontal sashing pieces by connecting ends and cutting them the length of the width of your finished finished rows. *You will need 5 sashings*.
- 6 Repeat #5 with the black horizontal sashings. You will need 4 sashings.
- ⑦ Once sashings are cut to length, piece all rows together as shown (Fig. 2)
- 8 Layer the quilt back, batting, and the quilt top. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired, removing the basting as you go. Bind to finish!
