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## FOX TROT OUILT FEATURING ED EMBERLEY'S PICTURE PIE

$3 / 4$ yard each: Foxes \& Raccoon
1/3 yard each: Scribble \{Black, Orange, Blue \& Gray\}
1/2 yard: White
$1 / 2$ yard Scribble \{Gray\} for binding
4 yards Alphabet for backing

## Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.

From each Foxes and Raccoon (cut lengthwise)

- 6 - $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ x $24^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ x $161 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- 2- $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From each Scribble \{Blue \& Gray\}

- 8- $41 / 2$ " x $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$

From Scribble \{Orange\}

- 12-21/2" x $8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

From Scribble \{Black\}

- 16-2½" x $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$

White:

- 28- $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$


## ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

1. Sew together one White piece and one Black Scribble ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangular piece on the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inch side. Continue alternating white and black until 8 pieces are sewn together ( 4 white and 4 black total) [fig 1]. Make 3 more strips ( 4 total) and press to the dark fabric.
2. Repeat Step 1 using the Orange Scribble and White ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) pieces (4 Orange and 4 White total for each strip) [fig 2]. Make 2 more strips ( 3 total) and press to the dark fabric.

## ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

3. Arrange the remainder of the fabric pieces according to the quilt diagram working in vertical
rows. Row 1: sew a Fox ( $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ ") piece to a Gray Scribble ( $41 / 2$ " x $81 / 2$ ") piece. Then add another Fox ( $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) piece and end row with Gray Scribble ( $41 / 2$ " x $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) piece. Row 1 is complete. [fig 3] Follow OUILT DIAGRAM noting correct order and size of fabric. Press to the dark fabrics.
4. After all vertical rows are pieced, sew vertical Rows 1 and 2 together, rows 3 and 4 together.
Continue sequence until quilt is pieced.
5. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
