

FREE PROJECT SHEET PLUS AND MINUS QUILT | SIZE 40" x 60"



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MATERIALS

PLUS AND MINUS OUILT FEATURING CIRRUS SOLIDS BY CLOUD9 FABRICS

Fat quarters of each: Ash, Lava, Sprout, Lilac, Mint, Coral, Lagoon, Amazon, Bubblegum, Butter, Rain, Fuchsia, Clementine

¹/₈ yards of each: Grass, Iris, Shamrock, Salmon, Sky, Amber, Petal, Turquoise

11/8 yards Limestone for Background

1/2 yard Limestone for Binding

3²/₃ yards Ash for Backing

Note: All possible care has been taken to assure the accuracy of this pattern. We are not responsible for printing errors or the manner in which individual work varies. Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

From Rain, Coral, Lava, Clementine:

4- 4½" x 4½" squares

2- 3½" x 2½" rectangles

1- 2½" x 8½" rectangle

4- 1½" x 2½" rectangles

From Sprout, Lilac, Mint, Lagoon, Amazon,

Bubblegum, Butter, Fuchsia:

4- 4½" x 4½" squares

4- 1½" x 2½" rectangles

From Grass, Iris, Shamrock, Salmon, Sky,

Amber, Petal, Turquoise:

2- 3½" x 2½" rectangles

1- 2½" x 8½" rectangle

From Ash:

12- 2½" x 8½" rectangles

From Limestone:

24- 4½" x 10½" rectangles

24- 2½" x 1½" rectangles

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

THE MINUS BLOCK

- 1. Sew a 2½" x 1½" Limestone rectangle to each end of the 2½" x 8½" Ash rectangle. Make 12. [fig 1]
- 2. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Limestone rectangle to the top and bottom of each unit made in Step 1. Make 12 blocks. [fig 2]

THE PLUS BLOCK

3. Arrange the following Cirrus Solids for the plus sign and the background fabric in sets.

Plus Sign • 2- 3½" x 2½" rectangles • 1- 2½" x 8½" rectangle	<i>Background</i> • 4- 4½" x 4½" squares • 4- 1½" x 2½" rectangles
Clementine	Lava
Grass	Sprout
Iris	Lilac
Shamrock	Mint
Salmon	Coral
Sky	Lagoon
Rain	Amazon
Lava	Bubblegum
Amber	Butter
Turquoise	Rain
Petal	Fuchsia
Coral	Clementine

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

- 4. Sew a 1½" x 2½" background rectangle to each end of the 2½" x 8½" plus sign rectangle as in Step 1, fig 1.
- 5. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to *one end* of each $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " plus sign rectangle. [fig 3] Make 2 for each color combination.
- 6. Add a 4½" background square to each side of the two units pieced in Step 5. [fig 4]
- 7. Sew the unit made in Step 4 to the two units made in Step 6. [fig 5]

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

- 8. Refer to the QUILT DIAGRAM for color placement and arrange the Plus and Minus blocks in six horizontal rows of four blocks each. Sew the blocks together in rows, pressing seam allowances in alternating directions from row to row. Sew the rows together to complete quilt top.
- 9. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste, quilt as desired, and bind.
