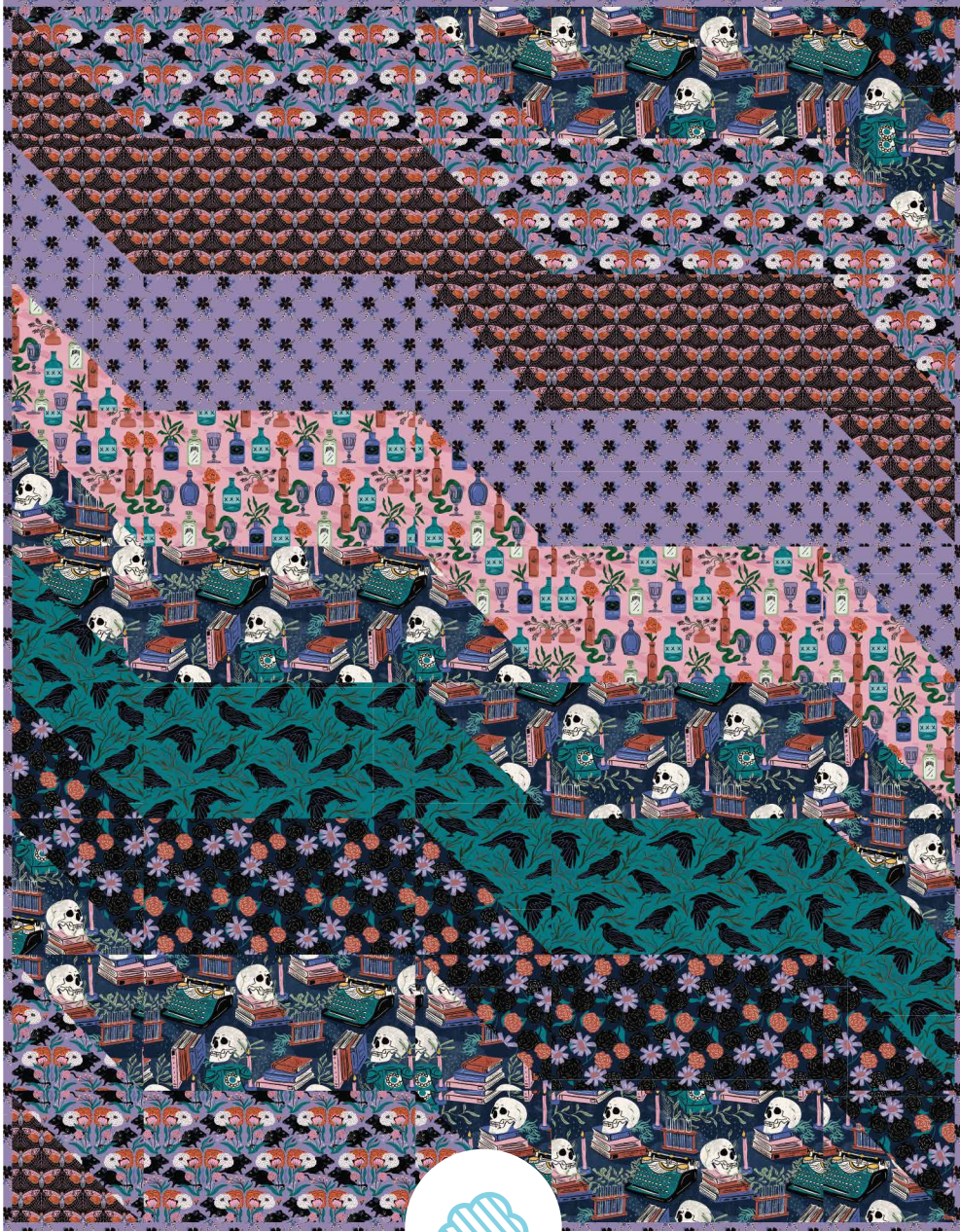

See chart below for fabric quantities

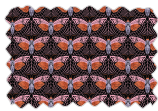
½ yd binding

3 ½ yards backing

Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

QUILT FACE MATERIALS

Cutting dimensions include ¼" seam allowances.



FABRIC A

227312 Death's Head Moth

½ yds needed

2- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

4- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



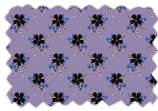
FABRIC E

½ yds needed

2- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

3- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



FABRIC B

227316 Moonstone Botanical

½ yds needed

2- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

3- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



FABRIC F

227315 Black Marigolds

½ yds needed

2- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

4- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



FABRIC C

227314 Poisonous Potions

½ yds needed

2- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

3- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



FABRIC G

227313 Toxic Garden

½ yds needed

3- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

4- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares



FABRIC D

227310 Edgar's Writing Room

1 yds needed

5- 7" x 13 ½" rectangles

7- 7 ½" x 7 ½" squares

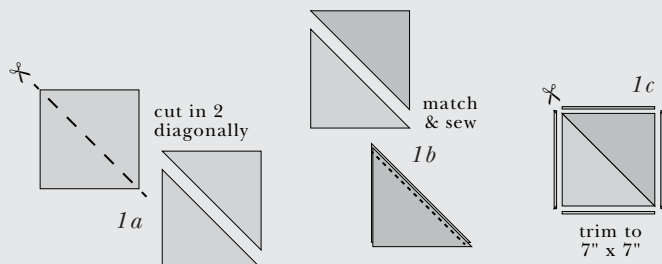
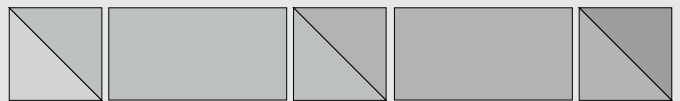


fig 2 row assembly



ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

1. Cut pieces using chart on page 2
2. Cut each square in half diagonally, corner to corner [fig 1a]
3. Match triangle colors to their mate [fig 1b] according to QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM. Pay attention to direction of fabrics as you go. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam.
4. Trim new squares to 7" x 7" [fig 1c]
5. Referring to QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM layout out the pieces and then begin to assemble the rows [fig 2].
6. Sew rows together as shown, pressing seams as you go.
7. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
