$31 / 2$ yards backing

## QUILT FACE MATERIALS

Cutting dimensions include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances.


227509 Dot Dot Dot $1 / 2$ yds needed
2- $7^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
4- $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2$ " squares


227510 Plant Seeds $1 / 2$ yds needed
2-7" x 13 1/2" rectangles 3- $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2$ " squares

227505 Cozy Library
$1 / 2$ yds needed
2- $7^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
3- $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares


227507 Rosy Glasses
$1 / 2$ yds needed
2- $7^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles
3-71/2" $\times 71 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares


227508 Books Grow $1 / 2$ yds needed
2- $7^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles 3- $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2$ " squares


227503 Reading Garden $1 / 2$ yds needed
2-7" x 13 1/2" rectangles 4- $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2 "$ squares

227506 Book Shelf $1 / 2$ yds needed
3-7" x $131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
4- $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2$ " squares

## DIAGRAMS



1. Cut pieces using chart on page 2
2. Cut each square in half diagonally, corner to corner [fig 1a]
3. Match triangle colors to their mate [fig 1b] according to QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM.

Pay attention to direction of fabrics as you go. Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seam.
4. Trim new squares to $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ [fig 1c]
5. Referring to QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM layout out the pieces and then begin to assemble the rows [fig 2].
6. Sew rows together as shown, pressing seams as you go.
7. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
