## CLOUD9 <br> FABRICS

This project uses 8 different fabrics

See chart below for fabric quantities
$21 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ background fabric $1 / 2$ yd binding
3 3/4 yards backing

SIZE: $581 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$

Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

## QUILT FACE MATERIALS

## Cutting dimensions include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances.

$1 / 2$ yds each of 8 different printed fabrics (see chart below)
2-13" squares from each fabric
4-3/4" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips from FABR|C A, C, F, G (for stems)

From background fabric cut:
32-41/2" squares
16-4" squares
12-121/2" x $21 / 2$ " sashing strips 5-54" x 21/2" (peiced from WOF strips)
2-60" x $2^{1 / 2}$ " sashing strips (pieced from WOF strips)

Use a solid fabric that
is the same color on both
sides and has no pattern

## ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

1. Place two 13 " printed fabric squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line and sew $1 / 4$ " along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. Trim to $12^{1 / 2}$ " square. [fig 1]
2. Cut the $164^{\prime \prime}$ squares from BACKGROUND FABRIC in half diagonally and insert FABRIC A, $C$, F, G $3 / 4 " \times 6 "$ strips to make stem squares. Trim to $3^{1 / 2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ square. [fig 2]
3. Pin the background $4 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the two corners of the print blocks that have no seams.

Sew diagonally, trim corners, open, and press flat. [fig 3]
4. Pin the $31 / 2 "$ stem square to one corner with a seam. Sew diagonally, trim the corner and press flat. [fig 3]
5. Arrange blocks according to QUILT DIAGRAM. Insert BACKGROUND FABRIC $12 \frac{1}{2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 2 \mathbf{2}^{1 / 2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to make rows. [fig 4]
6. Piece BACKGROUND FABRIC sashing strips $54^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " and sew between rows as well as along top and bottom. [fig 4]
7. Piece BACKGROUND FABRIC sashing strips $60^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ and sew to sides of quilt.
8. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
